The Veterinarian determined that the dog was not a surgical candidate due to concerns associated with physical findings associated with an infection of the leg, and lab work. The

Veterinarian issued a rule out diagnosis of cancer which the owner disputed, and the veterinarian presented a treatment plan and follow-up care. Ultimately, the Board of Veterinary Medicine determined that the Veterinarian did not deviate from the standard of care in her assessment of the history, physical and diagnostic tests performed resulting in the proffered treatment plan.
